4 cases are yours. So, you can just stay right
5 there. Thank you. Would the parties in the
6 matter of Stanton Liquors please come forward.
7 Stanton Liquors. This is Case number 18-PRO-
8 000045. How do you pronounce this, Yoef, Inc?

9 MR. ALAZAR: Yoef, ma'am.

10 AGENT FLETCHER: Excuse me, Raj. Raj.
11 Excuse me, Raj. Thank you. 1044 Bladensburg
12 Road NE, License number 071601. This is a
13 Retailer Class A license renewal. Don't touch
14 the microphone. Thank you.

15 The protest issues are adverse impact
16 on peace, order, and quiet, residential parking,
17 and vehicular and pedestrian safety, and real
18 property values.

19 My name is LaVerne Fletcher,
20 conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's
21 Agent. Introductions, beginning with the
22 applicant, please. Your name, sir?

5 AGENT FLETCHER: I'm sorry, what's the
6 first letter?

9 MR. ALAZAR: E like elephant.

10 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Just one
11 second please, thank you. Let me just try one
12 more time. What's the first letter?

14 M.

15 AGENT FLETCHER: Can you write that
16 for me? There's a sign in sheet. If you could
17 write your name, your contact information so that
18 we can reach you beyond today?

19 MR. ALAZAR: Right here? Where?

20 AGENT FLETCHER: Yes. Right there.
21 There's a place for your name, email address, and
22 telephone number. Present on behalf of ANC 5D.

1 MR. LEE: Yes.

2 AGENT FLETCHER: If you could state
3 your name, and spell it for the record, please.

4 MR. LEE: Clarence Lee, L-E-E.

5 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Lee.
6 ANC 5D has standing as a protestant. We need to
7 set a date for a mediation, a status hearing, and
8 a protest hearing. I'll give you the date for

1 MR. ALAZAR: All right. 11:00 a.m. is
2 okay.

3 AGENT FLETCHER: Is that okay for you,
4 Mr. Lee?

5 MR. LEE: That's fine.

6 MR. ALAZAR: It should, it's going to
7 be here, right?

8 AGENT FLETCHER: Yes. Mediation is
9 set for Tuesday, July 3rd, at 11:00 a.m. Any
10 questions at all?

11 MR. ALAZAR: No thanks.

12 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you for
13 coming.

14 MR. LEE: Thank you.

15 AGENT FLETCHER: You're welcome. The
16 roll call hearing is concluded.
