**ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE AND
REINSTATING LICENSE**

On June 8, 2022, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) cancelled the Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-092362 held by MJA, LLC, t/a Stoney's on L (Petitioner), because the Petitioner failed to renew its license and request a safekeeping extension by March 31, 2022, the deadline for renewal of all Retailer's Class CR licenses. *See* Board Order No. 2022-273.

On June 13, 2022, Risa Hirao, Esq., on behalf of the Petitioner, sought reinstatement of the Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-092362. In support of its request for reinstatement, the Petitioner indicated that all issues preventing the Petitioner from renew its license and request a safekeeping extension have been resolved.

The Board finds that the reinstatement of the license is proper conditioned upon the requirement that the Petitioner submits the renewal application and pays the license fees.

Accordingly, it is this 29th day of June 2022, **ORDERED** that the **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE** issued against the Petitioner, by the Board on June 8, 2022, be and hereby is **VACATED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that its Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-092362 be **REINSTATED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petitioner pay the required fees and request a safekeeping extension within two (2) weeks from the date of this Order.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010).

However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
