ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE AND REINSTATING LICENSE

On June 8, 2022, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) cancelled the Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-092362 held by MJA, LLC, t/a Stoney's on L (Petitioner), because the Petitioner failed to renew its license and request a safekeeping extension by March 31, 2022, the deadline for renewal of all Retailer's Class CR licenses. *See* Board Order No. 2022-273.

On June 13, 2022, Risa Hirao, Esq., on behalf of the Petitioner, sought reinstatement of the Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-092362. In support of its request for reinstatement, the Petitioner indicated that all issues preventing the Petitioner from renew its license and request a sefakeeping extension have been resolved.

The Board finds that the reinstatement of the license is proper conditioned upon the requirement that the Petitioner submits the renewal application and pays the license fees.



However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion.
