3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
4 everyone. I would like to welcome you to the
5 regularly scheduled meeting of the District of
6 Columbia Alcoholic Beverage Control Board.
7 Please know that today's hearings will be
8 conducted in accordance with D.C. Official Code
9 Section 2-574 of the Open Meetings Act.

10 Today is June 13, 2018. I would like

18 Board and we have seven Members today, which is
19 wonderful, and so we do have a quorum.
