ORDER GRANTING WITHDRAWAL

The Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board (Board), on this 25th day of September 2024, hereby **GRANTS** the Respondent, Perry Young’s request to voluntarily withdraw the request for a hearing on the Notice of Summary Action in the above captioned matter. The parties are advised that the withdrawal of the hearing request waives the right to legally challenge the summary closure issued under D.C. Official Code § 7-1671.08(g)(1), 2(C), and (3). MPD and ABCA shall retain the right to padlock the premises and seize any cannabis or cannabis products found on the premises pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 7-1671.08(g)(1). The Board may consider modifying this Order or the terms of the summary closure upon the submission and approval of a reasonable remediation plan by the property owner that prevents the recurrence of illegal cannabis activity at the premises. The ABCA shall deliver a copy of this order to the Parties.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1) (applicable to alcohol matters) or 22-C DCMR § 9720 (applicable to medical cannabis matters), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001 (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. *See* D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
