4 We're back on the record. Is there a translator
5 here?

6 INTERPRETER HUIE: Yes, sir.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Please, stand
8 up. What language is this?

9 INTERPRETER HUIE: This is Mandarin.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mandarin.
11 Okay. Could you raise your right hand, please?

12 Do you solemnly affirm that you will
13 faithfully and accurately interpret these
14 proceedings in this matter from English to
15 Mandarin and from Mandarin into English to the
16 best of your ability?

17 INTERPRETER HUIE: Yes, I do.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Have a seat,
19 please. All right.

20 All right. Our next case is Case No.
21 18-CMP-00223, Sushi Keiko, License No. 94610.

22 Will the parties, please, identify

1 themselves for the record, please?

2 MS. PHILLIPS: Louise Phillips,
3 Assistant Attorney General for the District of
4 Columbia.

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good afternoon,
6 Ms. Phillips.

7 MR. ZHANG: My name Wei Zhang.

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I didn't hear
9 your name.

10 MR. ZHANG: Wei Zhang. Wei, W-E-I,
11 first, that's first name. Last name Z-H-A-N-G.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good afternoon,
13 sir.

14 MR. ZHANG: Good afternoon.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

16 This matter is scheduled for a Show Cause
17 Hearing. Are there any preliminary matters in
18 this case, Ms. Phillips?

19 MS. PHILLIPS: Yes, Mr. Chair, there
20 are. The parties have discussed both with the
21 interpreter and without the interpreter the fact
22 that and agreed on an Offer in Compromise of a

1 written warning.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Mr.
3 Zhang?

4 MR. ZHANG: Zhang.

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Zhang.

6 MR. ZHANG: Yes.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

8 It's my understanding that there is an Offer in
9 Compromise.

10 MR. ZHANG: Yes.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ma'am, are you
12 -- you are a translator.

13 INTERPRETER HUIE: Yes.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So therefore
15 you are supposed to translate everything that I'm
16 saying.

17 MR. ZHANG: Yes.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And the Offer
19 in Compromise is that the party has agreed to a
20 written warning.

21 INTERPRETER HUIE: Is to agree, sorry?

22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Agreed to a

1 written warning.

2 MR. ZHANG: Yes.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is this your
4 understanding, sir, of the Offer in Compromise?

5 MR. ZHANG: Yes, I understand.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware
7 that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that
8 you are giving up your right to a hearing?

9 MR. ZHANG: Yes, I understand.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you also
11 aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise,
12 that you are giving up your right to appeal this
13 matter?

14 MR. ZHANG: Yes, I understand.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
16 With that said, I then make a motion that the
17 Offer in Compromise of a written warning be
18 accepted. Is there a second?

19 MEMBER CATO: Second.

20 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato has
22 seconded the motion.

1 All those in favor say aye.

2 ALL: Aye.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?

4 The matter passes 4-0-0.

5 Thank you very much. The matter is
6 over. We will have you sign-off on this
7 paperwork, sir.

8 MR. ZHANG: Okay.

9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you very
10 much.

11 MS. PHILLIPS: Thank you, Board
12 Members.

13 MR. ZHANG: Thank you very much.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: You're welcome.
15 Have a good day.

16 MR. ZHANG: We finished?

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yeah, we are
18 finished, yes. She is going to give you a copy
19 of the document, yes.

20 MR. ZHANG: A copy.
