4 on our calendar is Case No. 18-CMP-00177, The  
5 Matchbox, License No. 60581.

6 Would the parties, please, approach  
7 and identify themselves for the record, please?

8 MS. PHILLIPS: Louise Phillips,  
9 Assistant Attorney General, for the District of  
10 Columbia.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Phillips.

12 MS. YOHANNES: Sidon Yohannes on  
13 behalf of the licensee.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,  
15 Ms. Yohannes.

16 Ms. Phillips, are there any  
17 preliminary matters in this case?

18 MS. PHILLIPS: Yes, Mr. Chair, there  
19 are. The parties have agreed upon an Offer in  
20 Compromise to present to the Board. It's a one  
21 charge case. The fine is \$2,000 to be paid  
22 within 30 days or the license will be suspended

1 indefinitely until the fine is paid.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Yohannes,  
3 it's my understanding that there is an Offer in  
4 Compromise and the Offer in Compromise is that  
5 there is a fine of \$2,000 payable in 30 days. If  
6 the fine is not payable in 30 days, the license  
7 will be suspended until the fine has been paid.

8 Is this your understanding of the  
9 Offer in Compromise?

10 MS. YOHANNES: Yes, it is.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is your client  
12 aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise,  
13 that they are giving up their right to a hearing?

14 MS. YOHANNES: Yes.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And is your  
16 client also aware that by accepting an Offer in  
17 Compromise, that they are giving up their right  
18 to appeal this matter?

19 MS. YOHANNES: Yes.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: With this said,  
21 I then make a motion that the Offer in Compromise  
22 of a fine of \$2,000 payable in 30 days be

1       accepted.  If the fine is not payable in 30 days,  
2       the license will be suspended until the fine has  
3       been paid.

4                       Is there a second?

5                       MEMBER SILVERSTEIN:  Second.

6                       CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON:  Mr. Silverstein  
7       has seconded the motion.

8                       All those in favor say aye.

9                       ALL:  Aye.

10                      CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON:  Those opposed?

11       The matter passes 4-0-0.

12                      Thank you.

13                      MS. YOHANNES:  Um-hum.
