ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE AND REINSTATING LICENSE

On July 10, 2019, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) cancelled the Retailer Class DR License ABRA-001104 held by Gallaudet College, t/a The Abbey Rathskeller, because Gallaudet College failed to renew its license by March 31, 2019. See Board Order No. 2019-541.

On September 4, 2019, Roberta Cordano, on behalf of Gallaudet College (Petitioner), sought reinstatement of the Retailer's Class DR License ABRA-001104. In support of her request for reinstatement, Ms. Cordano stated that the Petitioner was unable to renew its license because the Petitioner was in the process of seeking approval of new officers by the Board of Trustees. Ms. Cordano now informs the Board that the Petitioner's new officers have been approved.

The Board finds that the reinstatement of the license is proper conditioned upon the requirement that the Petitioner renews its license and pays the required fees.

Accordingly, it is this 11th day of September, 2019, **ORDERED** that the **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE** issued against Gallaudet College, t/a The Abbey Rathskeller, by the Board on July 10, 2019, be and hereby is **VACATED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Retailer's Class DR License ABRA-001104 be REINSTATED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petitioner renew and pay the required fees within two (2) weeks from the date of this Order.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
