8	MR. ADAMS: Good morning, Mr.
9	Chairman. Walter Adams representing the District
10	of Columbia.
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
12	Mr. Adams.
13	MS. KAYS: Good morning. My name is
14	Allison Kays, General Manager for Big Stick.
15	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Kays, do
16	you have a letter, an authorization letter with
17	you this morning?
18	MS. KAYS: I do.
19	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Can I have
20	can you show that to Mr. Adams? And then you can
21	provide a copy to the Agency, please.
22	MS. KAYS: Yes.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Mr
Adams, are there any preliminary matters in this
case?

MR. ADAMS: Yes, Mr. Chairman, there are preliminary matters. For this case, there is two charges. One for -- Charge 1 for the establishment allowing a patron to exit the premises with an open container and Charge 2 for no ABC Manager. We were able to resolve the case for a total fine of \$2,500 and to be paid today.

If the establishment does not make such payment today, he understands his license shall be suspended until such payment is made.

And how it breaks down, Mr. Chairman, is that for Charge 1, there will be a fine in the amount of \$1,250 and Charge 2, there will also be a fine in the amount of \$1,250. Thus, making the total amount up to \$2,500.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. Ms. Kays, it's my understanding that there is an Offer in Compromise and the Offer in Compromise is that for Charge 1, there is a fine of \$1,250.

For Charge 2, there is also a fine of \$1,250 for a total fine of \$2,500 to be paid today. If the fine is not payable -- made -- if the fine is not paid today, the license will be suspended until the fine has been paid.

Is this your understanding of the Offer in Compromise?

MS. KAYS: Yes.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that you are giving up your right to a hearing?

MS. KAYS: Yes.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you also aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that you are giving up your right to appeal this matter?

MS. KAYS: Yes.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: With this said,

I then make a motion that the Offer in Compromise

for Charge 1 a fine of \$1,250, for Charge 2,

\$1,250 for a total fine of \$2,500 payable today.

If the fine is not payable today, the license
