3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case
4 on our calendar is Case No. 18-AUD-00111, The Big
5 Stick.

6 Would the parties, please, approach
7 and identify themselves for the record, please?

8 MR. ADAMS: Oh, sorry. Good morning,
9 Mr. Chairman. Walter Adams representing the
10 District of Columbia.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Adams.

12 MS. KAYS: I'm Allison Kays, General
13 Manager of The Big Stick.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Kays or
15 Keys?

16 MS. KAYS: Kays, K-A-Y-S.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Kays. Do you
18 have a Letter of Representation?

19 MS. KAYS: Yes.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Can you provide
21 that to us, please?

22 MS. KAYS: Yes.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. All
2 right. Mr. Adams, are there any preliminary
3 matters in this case?

4 MR. ADAMS: There is a preliminary
5 matter, Mr. Chairman, or are preliminary matters.
6 The parties have discussed this case and are able
7 to propose an Offer in Compromise.

8 Again, for a single charge of the
9 establishment not having or failing to file a
10 quarterly statement in a timely manner. The
11 parties propose a fine in the amount of \$2,000 to
12 be paid in a period of 60 days. And if the
13 licensee fails to pay the fine within the 60-day
14 period, its -- the license shall be suspended
15 indefinitely until the fine is paid.

16 That is the proposal. Otherwise, we--
17 that the establishment shall submit the pending
18 quarterly statements.

19 However, in this case, the Board
20 should note that the establishment has submitted
21 the outstanding quarterly statement at this
22 point. So at this point, it's just asking for --

1 or proposing a fine.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Ms.
3 Kays, it's my understanding that there is an
4 Offer in Compromise and the Offer in Compromise
5 is that there would be a fine of \$2,000 payable
6 within 60 days. If the fine is not payable
7 within 60 days, the license will be suspended
8 until the fine has been paid. Is this your
9 understanding of the Offer in Compromise?

10 MS. KAYS: Yes.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware
12 that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that
13 you are giving up your right to a hearing?

14 MS. KAYS: Yes.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And also by --
16 are you aware that by accepting an Offer in
17 Compromise, that you are giving up your right to
18 appeal this matter?

19 MS. KAYS: Yes.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
21 With that said, I then make a motion that the
22 Offer in Compromise of a fine of \$2,000 payable

1 in 60 days be accepted. If the fine is not
2 payable in 60 days, the license will be suspended
3 until the fine has been paid.

4 Is there a second?

5 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Silverstein
7 has seconded the motion.

8 All those in favor say aye.

9 ALL: Aye.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?

11 The matter passes 6-0-0.

12 Thank you. I'll have you sign-off.

13 Thanks.
