Therefore, on this 16th day of January 2019, the Board **APPROVES** the offer-incompromise submitted by the parties, which resolves the matter as follows:

- 1. In Case Number 18-CMP-00140, the parties agree to resolve Charge I by the issuance of a WARNING.
- 2. In Case Number 18-CMP-00131, the license holder admits to the violation described in Charge I and pay a \$1,250 fine within 30 days from the date of this Order or its license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine payment is made. The violation described by Charge I shall be deemed a secondary tier violation.

The ABRA shall deliver copies of this Order to the Government and the Respondent.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, Reeves Center, 2000 14th Street, NW, 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202-879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. *See* D.C.
