3 MS. FLETCHER: Would the parties in
4 the matter of The Brixton please come forward,
5 the parties in the matter of The Brixton?

9 Class CT License Renewal.

10 The protest issues are adverse impact
11 on peace, order and quiet, residential parking
12 and vehicular and pedestrian safety.

13 My name is Laverne Fletcher conducting
14 the roll call hearing as the Board's agent.
15 Introductions, beginning with the applicant,

17 MR. HERMAN: Scott Herman, S-C-O-T-T
18 H-E-R-M-A-N.

19 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Herman.
20 We did receive the letter designating you as the
21 representative for the applicant.

22 MR. HERMAN: Thank you.

23 MS. FLETCHER: And present on behalf
24 of ANC 1B?

25 MS. NORMAN: Anita Norman, A-N-I-T-A

1 N-O-R-M-A-N.

2 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.

3 Mr. Herman, would you put your contact
4 information on that sheet?

5 MR. HERMAN: Yes.

6 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you. Thank
7 you. I need to give you a date for a status
8 hearing, a protest hearing and a mediation.

9 I'm going to give you the date for the
10 status and protest hearing first. The date for
11 the status hearing is February 26. That's
12 February 26 at 9:30 a.m. for the status hearing.

13 The protest hearing is set for April
14 1. April 1, 2020 at 1:30 for the protest
15 hearing.

16 I will give you the next available day
17 for mediation. We actually have a 9 o'clock spot
18 on January 23rd, if you want to come in the
19 morning. That is on a Thursday, January 23rd, at
20 9:00.

21 MR. HERMAN: That works.

22 MS. NORMAN: At 9:00 a.m.?

23 MS. FLETCHER: At 9:00 a.m.

24 MS. NORMAN: Okay.

25 MS. FLETCHER: 9:00 a.m. --

1 MR. HERMAN: Sorry, just to confirm,
2 if we need to reschedule, because I just need to
3 check with our lawyer about her --

4 MS. FLETCHER: Oh, yeah.

5 MR. HERMAN: -- availability, is that
6 suitable?

7 MS. FLETCHER: Yeah, my card is on the
8 table. You can call me, but you're going to
9 receive an official hearing notice with all these
10 dates. And so my number will be on that letter
11 too, so.

12 MR. HERMAN: Okay. Thank you.

13 MS. FLETCHER: Uh-huh. And, Ms.
14 Norman, if that happens, I'll let you know.

15 MS. NORMAN: Okay. Appreciate that.

16 MS. FLETCHER: Mediation is set for
17 January 23rd, 9 o'clock a.m. Any questions at
18 all?

19 MR. HERMAN: No.

20 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you for coming.
21 The roll call hearing is concluded. Thank you.
