The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met in the Alcoholic Beverage Control Hearing Room, Reeves Building, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009, Chairperson Donovan W. Anderson, presiding.

3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. The
4	next case on our calendar is Case No. 18-CMP-
5	00058, The Elroy, License No. 96771.
6	Would the parties, please, approach
7	and identify themselves for the record, please?
8	MR. RIVERO: Good morning, Board
9	Members. Fernando Rivero for the District of
10	Columbia.
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
12	Mr. Rivero.
13	MS. DURANTE-MILLER: Donna Durante-
14	Miller.
15	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I'm sorry,
16	Miss? You did the same thing the gentleman did
17	before. I cannot hear your last name.
18	MS. DURANTE-MILLER: Donna Durante-
19	Miller, Bar Manager.
20	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
21	Ms. Miller.
22	Ms. Miller, do you have an

1	authorization letter to say that you can				
2	represent this establishment?				
3	MS. DURANTE-MILLER: Yes, sir.				
4	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Can we can				
5	you provide that to us, please?				
6	Mr. Rivero, have you seen it?				
7	MR. RIVERO: I haven't, but I have				
8	asked her for a copy yesterday, so				
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay.				
10	MR. RIVERO: she has to bring it.				
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay.				
12	MR. RIVERO: The Government is				
13	satisfied with the letter.				
14	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.				
15	Thank you. All right. Are there any preliminary				
16	matters in this case?				
17	MR. RIVERO: Yes. The parties have an				
18	Offer in Compromise to present to the Board at				
19	this time. The offer consists of:				
20	For Charge 1, dismissal of the charge;				
21	And for Charge 2, payment of a fine of				
22	\$2,500 within 30 days and if the fine is not paid				

1 within 30 days, the license will be suspended 2 until payment is received. The dismissal of Charge 1 is pursuant 3 to a review of the evidence. The licensee, in 4 5 fact, had the appropriate cover charge endorsement on the date of the incident. 6 So we 7 don't have the evidence to sustain that charge 8 and we are dismissing it. 9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. MR. RIVERO: But that's the Offer in 10 11 Compromise, at this time. 12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 13 Thank you. 14 MR. RIVERO: You're welcome. 15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Durante-16 Miller, it's my understanding that there is an 17 Offer in Compromise. And the Offer in Compromise 18 is that Charge 1 will be dismissed. 19 For Charge 2, there is a fine of 20 \$2,500 payable in 30 days. If the fine is not 21 payable in 30 days, the license will be suspended until the fine has been paid. 22

Is this your understanding of the 1 2 Offer in Compromise? 3 MS. DURANTE-MILLER: Yes, sir. 4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware 5 that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that you are giving up your right to a hearing? 6 MS. DURANTE-MILLER: Yes, sir. 7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: 8 Are you also 9 aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that you are giving up your right to appeal this 10 11 matter? 12 MS. DURANTE-MILLER: Yes, sir. 13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: With that said, 14 I then make a motion that the Offer in Compromise of a fine of -- the Offer in Compromise be 15 16 accepted. Charge 1 will be dismissed and Charge 17 2, that there will be a fine of \$2,500 payable in 18 30 days. If the fine is not payable in 30 days, 19 the license will be suspended until the fine has 20 been paid. Is there a second? 21 MEMBER SHORT: Second. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has 22

1	seconded the motion.
