FLETCHER: Is that the list because the protestants live in different units? 15 16 MR. OAKS: Well --17 MS. FLETCHER: Correct. So we got 18 them. 19 MR. OAKS: You got them? 20 MS. FLETCHER: Yeah, we have them all. 21 MR. OAKS: Excellent. 22 MS. FLETCHER: And it looks like some 23 of them are here today. So if you would just, 24 right in from of Mr. Oaks, there's a microphone -25 - if you could just state your name and spell it

As the designated 13 representative, it's up to you. We accept you as 14 being the representative for the whole group. 15 MR. OAKS: Correct. 16 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. ANC 2B has 17 standing as a protestant. The Dupont Circle 18 Citizens Association has standing as a protestant 19 as does the group of 12. 20 We need to set a date for mediation, 21 a status hearing and protest hearing. I'll give 22 you the date for the status and protest hearing 23 first. 24 The status hearing is set for March 25 11. That's March 11th at 9:30 a.m. for the

1 status hearing. 2 The protest hearing is set for April 3 8, April 8 at 4:30 for the protest hearing. 4 I'll give you the next available date for mediation. The next available day is 5 Thursday, April (sic) 20 -- that's Thursday, 6 7 April (sic) 20, anytime between 9:00 and 2:00. 8 MS. YOHANNES: February 20 or --9 MS. FLETCHER: February. We are now 10 into February. Mr. Oaks? 11 MR. OAKS: One more person. 12 MS. FLETCHER: One more? Okay, one 13 more has arrived for the protestants. 14 could just state your name and spell it for the 15 record. You don't need to sign that sign-in 16 sheet. I only needed Mr. Oaks' name on that. 17 MS. SNYDER: Okay. 18 MS. FLETCHER: But if you would just 19 state your name and spell it for the record. 20 MS. SNYDER: Judith Snyder, 21 S-N-Y-D-E-R. 22 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much. 23 So, yes, Ms. Yohannes, we've been looking at 24 February 20. That's Thursday, February, anytime

between 9:00 and 2:00.
