MS. FLETCHER: Would the parties in the matter of The Fireplace, parties in the matter of The Fireplace please come forward?

This is Case \#19-PRO-00140, The Fireplace Restaurant, LLC, 2161 P Street NW, License \#ABRA-014419. Retailer Class CT License Renewal.

The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order and quiet, residential parking and vehicular and pedestrian safety and real property values.

My name is Laverne Fletcher conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's agent. Present on behalf of the applicant, please? If you could just state your name and spell it for the record. We can start with you.

MR. WEINSTEIN: Steven Weinstein.
MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Weinstein, could you spell that, please?

MR. WEINSTEIN: S-T-E-V-E-N W-E-I-N-S-T-E-I-N.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
MR. GRISWELLM: Jeremiah Griswelm.

MS. FLETCHER: Could you spell that for the record, please?

MR. GRISWELM: J-E-R-E-M-I-A-H; last name Griswelm, G-R-I-S-W-E-L-M.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
MS. YOHANNES: And Sidon Yohannes, as counsel for the applicant. And that's S-I-D-O-N Y-O-H-A-N-N-E-S.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Are you with the applicant as well?

MR. SACCO: No.
MS. FLETCHER: Are you on that side? Okay. Okay, I'll just -- okay, that's okay. Thank you. Present of behalf of ANC 2B?

MR. SACCO: Peter Sacco. I'm the executive director for ANC 2B. S-A-C-C-O.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Sacco. Present on behalf of the Dupont Circle Citizens Association?

MS. VOLMAN: Susan Volman.
MS. FLETCHER: Could you spell your name for the record, please?

MS. VOLMAN: S-U-S-A-N V as in Victor, O-L-M-A-N.

MS. FLETCHER: And, Ms. Volman, I saw
from your protest letter that the applicant was given a 7-day notice to appear for the hearing. Did you get the notice, a 7-day notice to appear for a meeting?

MR. WEINSTEIN: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you. Just wanted to confirm that. Thank you. There is also a group of 12. Is Mr. Oaks here? Is that you, Mr. Oaks?

MR. OAKS: That's right. I am Rober Oaks, O-A-K-S. I'm the lead representative for the groups. If it helps any, I have the complete list as we submitted multiple petitions.

MS. FLETCHER: Is that the list because the protestants live in different units?

MR. OAKS: Well --
MS. FLETCHER: Correct. So we got them.

MR. OAKS: You got them?
MS. FLETCHER: Yeah, we have them all.
MR. OAKS: Excellent.
MS. FLETCHER: And it looks like some of them are here today. So if you would just, right in from of Mr. Oaks, there's a microphone -- if you could just state your name and spell it
for the record, please.
MR. HAYTHE: My name is Winston Haythe. That's W-I-N-S-T-O-N. And Haythe is H-A-Y-T-H-E.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Oh, but don't touch the microphone. The court reporter -- sorry.

MR. PADGET: Jonathan Padget, J-O-N-A-T-H-A-N P-A-D-G-E-T.

MS. FLETCHER: Spell the last name again.

MR. PADGET: P-A-D-G-E-T.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you.
MR. RUECKGAUER: Jeffrey Rueckgauer, J-E-F-F-R-E-Y R-U-E-C-K-G-A-U-E-R.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
MR. HEPNER: Seymour Hepner, S-E-Y-M-O-U-R H-E-P-N-E-R.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
MS. SIMON: Beth Simon, S-I-M-O-N.
MS. FLETCHER: And what was the first name, Ms. Simon?

MS. SIMON: Beth, B-E-T-H.
MS. FLETCHER: Oh, Beth? Okay, thank you.

MS. BRODER: Deborah Broder, D-E-B-O-R-A-H Broder, B-R-O-D-E-R.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Broder. Okay. Mr. Oaks, from your group, I count seven?

MR. OAKS: Correct.
MS. FLETCHER: That means that your group is granted full standing as protestants today. At the upcoming status hearing only you would need to appear on behalf of the group.

For the mediation, you may appear on behalf of the group or anyone from the group is welcome to attend, generally. As the designated representative, it's up to you. We accept you as being the representative for the whole group.

MR. OAKS: Correct.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. ANC 2B has standing as a protestant. The Dupont Circle Citizens Association has standing as a protestant as does the group of 12.

We need to set a date for mediation, a status hearing and protest hearing. I'll give you the date for the status and protest hearing first.

The status hearing is set for March
11. That's March 11th at 9:30 a.m. for the
status hearing.
The protest hearing is set for April 8, April 8 at 4:30 for the protest hearing.

I'll give you the next available date for mediation. The next available day is Thursday, April (sic) 20 -- that's Thursday, April (sic) 20, anytime between 9:00 and 2:00. MS. YOHANNES: February 20 or --

MS. FLETCHER: February. We are now into February. Mr. Oaks?

MR. OAKS: One more person.
MS. FLETCHER: One more? Okay, one more has arrived for the protestants. If you could just state your name and spell it for the record. You don't need to sign that sign-in sheet. I only needed Mr. Oaks' name on that.

MS. SNYDER: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: But if you would just state your name and spell it for the record.

MS. SNYDER: Judith Snyder, S-N-Y-D-E-R.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
So, yes, Ms. Yohannes, we've been looking at February 20. That's Thursday, February, anytime between 9:00 and 2:00.

MS. YOHANNES: I'm available -- so we're available anytime.

MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Sacco, do you have a preference?

MR. SACCO: I'm sorry, that was me?
MS. FLETCHER: Yes, do you have a preference for time?

MR. SACCO: No time. Whatever works for everybody.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Mr. Oaks, any preference?

MR. OAKS: Early is better for me.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay, well then let's make it 10 o'clock. Is that okay?

MR. SACCO: You said that's February 20th?

MS. FLETCHER: Yes, that's Thursday, February 20.

MR. SACCO: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: But you can go ahead and move it. So the mediation is set for Thursday, February 20 at 10:00. Any questions at all from anybody?

MS. YOHANNES: No questions.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.

The roll call hearing is concluded.
