**ORDER APPROVING THE OFFER-IN-COMPROMISE**

---

The above-mentioned parties have petitioned the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) to approve an offer-in-compromise (OIC) to settle one or more violations of Title 25 of the D.C. Official Code (Title 25) and Title 23 of the D.C. Municipal Regulations (Title 23) in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 2-509(a). The Parties appeared before the Board on December 14, 2022, and the Board approved the OIC at the hearing, which concluded this matter.

## **ORDER**

Therefore, on this 14th day of December 2022, the Board **APPROVES** the OIC appended to this Order. The terms of the OIC are as follows:

1. For the violation described in Charge I (D.C. Official Code § 25-762), the Respondent shall receive a fine of \$1,000.
2. All fines shall be paid within thirty days (30) or the license shall be indefinitely suspended until all money owed is paid.
3. The parties agree that the attached OIC constitutes the entire agreement of the parties.

ABRA shall deliver copies of this Order to the Government and the Respondent.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
