ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) determined that The Pitch, LLC, t/a The Pitch (Respondent), failed to renew its Retailer's Class CT License ABRA-095107 and cancelled the license in Board Order No. 2019-858, issued on November 6, 2019. The license holder subsequently filed a motion for reconsideration indicating that the failure to renew was due to the death of a family member and pandemic related complications. Nevertheless, the reconsideration motion was filed on August 26, 2020, long after the Board cancelled the license, and long after the period for filing for reconsideration and relief was legally available. As a result, the motion is out of order, untimely, and cannot be granted. Therefore, the Board, on this 16th day of September 2020, hereby **DENIES** the motion for reconsideration.
