3 MS. FLETCHER: Would the parties in
4 the matter of The Smith, please come forward?
5 Parties in the matter of The Smith.

7 Hospitality, LLC, 1314 U Street, NW, license
8 number ABRA-105790.

9 This is a retailer class CR license
10 renewal. My name is La Verne Fletcher,
11 conducting the Roll Call Hearing as the Board's
12 agent. Introductions beginning with the
13 applicant, please.

14 MR. MINORA: Sure. Matthew Minora
15 from the law firm of Mallios & O'Brien, on behalf
16 of the licensee.

18 MS. FLETCHER: Uh-huh. That's the
19 mediation date, if anybody's available.

20 MR. MINORA: It's Tuesday, May 28th at
21 2:00?

22 MS. FLETCHER: Yes.

2 MS. FLETCHER: Would that work for
3 you?

4 MR. MINORA: I believe so.

5 MS. FLETCHER: Well, I'll go ahead and
6 set it for that. If anything changes, you can
