The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met in the Alcoholic Beverage Control Hearing Room, Reeves Building, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009, Chairperson Donovan W. Anderson, presiding.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. The
4 next case on our calendar is Case No. 18-CMP-
5 00139, The Ugly Mug Dining Saloon, License No.
6 71793.

7 Will the parties, please, approach and
8 identify themselves for the record, please?

9 MR. RIVERO: Good morning, Board
10 Members. Fernando Rivero for the District of
11 Columbia.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
13 Mr. Rivero.

14 MR. JABLONSKI: Gaynor Jablonski,
15 owner Ugly Mug.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
17 Mr. Jablonski. If I butcher your name, let me
18 know, please.

19 MR. JABLONSKI: You got it. No, you
20 got it.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. Thank
22 you. All right. Are there any preliminary

1 matters in this case, Mr. Rivero?

2 MR. RIVERO: Yes. The parties have an
3 Offer in Compromise to present to the Board, at
4 this time, and the offer consists of a fine of
5 \$2,000 payable in 60 days. If the fine is not
6 paid in 60 days, the license will be suspended
7 until payment is received.

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.

9 MR. RIVERO: That's the Offer in
10 Compromise.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jablonski,
12 it's my understanding that there is an Offer in
13 Compromise and the Offer in Compromise is that
14 there is a fine of \$2,000 payable in 60 days. If
15 the fine is not payable in 60 days, the license
16 will be suspended until the fine has been paid.

17 Is this your understanding of the
18 Offer in Compromise?

19 MR. JABLONSKI: Yes, it is.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware
21 that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that
22 you are giving up your right to a hearing?

1 MR. JABLONSKI: Yes.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you also
3 aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise,
4 that you are giving up your right to appeal this
5 matter?

6 MR. JABLONSKI: Yes.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. With
8 that said, I then make a motion that the Offer in
9 Compromise of a fine of \$2,000 payable in 60 days
10 be accepted. If the fine is not payable in 60
11 days, the license will be suspended until the
12 fine has been paid.

13 Is there a second?

14 MEMBER SHORT: Second.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
16 seconded the motion.

17 All those in favor say aye.

18 ALL: Aye.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?
20 The matter passes 6-0-0.

21 Thank you very much. I'll have you
22 sign-off on some paperwork.

1 MR. JABLONSKI: Sure.

2 MR. RIVERO: Thank you.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

4 Well, it's not 10:00 yet, but I am on schedule,
5 you know, we try to be efficient here. So well,
6 it's 9:58, so is our 10:00 here? So is 1230 DC
7 here? I guess not. Then I guess I'll wait until
8 10:00 to do our 10:00. All right.
