ORDER RESCINDING APPROVAL OF ABRA LICENSE NO. ABRA-118513

Crescent Hotels & Resorts, LLC, t/a The Ven at Embassy Row (Applicant), filed an Application for a Retailer's Class B License (Application) at 2015 Massachusetts Avenue, NW, Washington, D.C. The Application was approved under Title 23 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations (DCMR) § 405.1, which authorizes the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board (Board) to issue a license to an applicant that lacks a certificate of occupancy for the premises so long as the applicant satisfies the requirements of Title 23 of DCMR 405.1.

However, approval of an application under § 405.1 is conditioned on the Applicant's payment of the annual license fee. Title 23 DCMR § 405.4. In this case, the Applicant failed to pay the annual license fee by September 30, 2023; therefore, the Applicant is not eligible to hold its License No. ABRA-118513 under § 405.1.

Therefore, on this 15th day of November 2023, the Board **RESCINDS** its previous approval of ABRA License No. ABRA-118513, held by the Applicant, and the license shall be deemed **CANCELLED**. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Applicant.

However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion.
