The Application filed by LOVE MORE THERAPY LLC, t/a Therapy (Applicant), for a New Medical Cannabis Retailer’s License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board (Board) Agent for a Roll Call Hearing on August 26, 2024. The Board scheduled a Protest Status Hearing for September 25, 2024 and only the Applicant appeared.

On September 25, 2024, the Board dismissed the Protest of Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 8C because the ANC failed to appear at the Protest Status Hearing. ANC 8C may file a Request for Reinstatement with the Board within ten (10) days from the date of this Order.

Pursuant to 23 DCMR §9723.1 (2003) any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
