3	AGENT FLETCHER: Would the parties in
4	the matter of Trump International Hotel,
5	Washington DC, please come forward? This is Case
6	Number 19-PRO-00036, Trump Old Post Office LLC,
7	1100 Pennsylvania Avenue Northwest, License
8	Number ABRA-1000648.
9	This is a Retailer Class CH license
10	renewal. The protest issue, not a good
11	character.
12	My name is La Verne Fletcher,
13	conducting a Roll Call Hearing as the Board's
14	Agent. Introductions beginning with the
15	Applicant, please.
16	MR. O'BRIEN: Stephen O'Brien for the
17	Applicant.
18	AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr.
19	O'Brien. So there's also a group of individuals
20	present on behalf of the group of individuals?
21	MR. LEVY: Joshua Levy.
22	AGENT FLETCHER: Mr. Levy, could you

1	spell your name for the record, please?
2	MR. LEVY: Sure, it's J-O-S-H-U-A,
3	middle initial A., last name, L-E, V as in
4	Victor, Y.
5	AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, and Mr.
6	Levy there are individuals from the group present
7	today?
8	MR. LEVY: Yes.
9	AGENT FLETCHER: If you would just
10	stand behind the microphone next to Mr. Levy and
11	state your name and spell it for the record.
12	Thank you.
13	MS. GOLDFRANK: Good morning retired
14	Judge Joan L. Goldfrank, J-O-A-N, middle initial
15	L., last name, G-O-L-D-F-R-A-N-K.
16	AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
17	MS. GOLDFRANK: Do you want us to sign
18	this too?
19	AGENT FLETCHER: No, that's fine if
20	Mr. Levy signs, that's all we need.
21	MR. LEVY: Okay.
22	MS. GOLDFRANK: Okay, thank you.

1	MR. POTEK: Good morning. Rabbi Aaron
2	Potek, A-A-R-O-N, last name, P-O-T-E-K.
3	AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you.
4	MR. MOLINE: Rabbi Jack Moline,
5	J-A-C-K, last name M-O-L-I-N-E.
6	AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you.
7	MS. BUTLER: Good morning, the
8	Reverend Jennifer Butler, J-E-N-N-I-F-E-R
9	B-U-T-L-E-R.
10	AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Reverend
11	Butler.
12	MR. LAMAR: Good morning, William H.
13	Lamar IV, W-I-L-L-I-A-M H. initial, L-A-M-A-R,
14	Roman numeral IV, no comma. William H. Lamar.
15	AGENT FLETCHER: What did you say your
16	name was again?
17	MR. LAMAR: William H. Lamar.
18	AGENT FLETCHER: Oh, I see it. Thank
19	you.
20	MR. LAMAR: Yes, ma'am.
21	AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you. Thank you
22	very much. So the record will reflect that

Mr. Levy you didn't sign the protest letter, 1 2 you're just a representative, right? Correct. 3 MR. LEVY: 4 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay, so the record 5 will reflect that five individuals that filed a 6 protest are present today. The Board's Agent 7 won't make a decision today about who has 8 standing or not because the Applicant's attorney 9 filed a motion to dismiss the protest. So that decision won't be made, but the record will 10 11 reflect that at least five individuals were 12 present today. 13 MR. LEVY: And they're excused from 14 appearing at the Status Hearing, these five 15 individuals? 16 AGENT FLETCHER: Yes. 17 MR. LEVY: Thank you. 18 AGENT FLETCHER: Mr. O'Brien? 19 MR. O'BRIEN: Yeah, I'm confused as to the five? 20 The five individuals 21 AGENT FLETCHER: that are present signed the protest letter. 22

1	MR. O'BRIEN: Actually, I don't think
2	any of them signed the protest letter, but
3	putting that aside
4	MR. LEVY: That's not correct.
5	AGENT FLETCHER: Yeah. So, Mr.
6	O'Brien, there may be I'm going to make sure
7	you get the document where they signed, maybe it
8	wasn't transmitted to you, but I'll make sure you
9	get it.
10	MR. O'BRIEN: But even then, I see
11	I don't see Rabbi Moline.
12	AGENT FLETCHER: Rabbi Moline
13	MR. O'BRIEN: I don't see him as a
14	Protestant.
15	AGENT FLETCHER: I'm going to let
16	me take a look here, Mr. O'Brien.
17	MR. O'BRIEN: I see him as a
18	Complainant back in September.
19	AGENT FLETCHER: Right.
20	MR. O'BRIEN: But I don't see him
21	listed as a Protestant, rather I see Albert
22	Fohler (phonetic).

So I have this name. 1 AGENT FLETCHER: 2 So what happened is Mr. Moline's name was not submitted originally. So my quess, Mr. O'Brien, 3 4 is you don't have the document where he was 5 added. Mr. Levy, he was added later. 6 7 MR. LEVY: Yes, that's correct. 8 AGENT FLETCHER: He was added before 9 the petition deadline, but later. MR. LEVY: Yeah, let me clarify two 10 things, if I may --11 12 AGENT FLETCHER: Yes. MR. LEVY: -- for both counsel and for 13 14 you, Ms. Fletcher. Number one, in conversations 15 with ABRA legal, ABRA confirmed with me that the 16 signatures from the Complainants submitted as an 17 attachment to the May 8th letter would suffice as 18 signatures for the Protestants. 19 AGENT FLETCHER: Yes. MR. LEVY: 20 Number two, we were asked 21 to submit names and addresses to ABRA.

And Rabbi Moline's name and address should

2	AGENT FLETCHER: Yes.
3	MR. LEVY: It was also in the original
4	complaint.
5	AGENT FLETCHER: It does appear
6	MR. LEVY: Thank you.
7	AGENT FLETCHER: And so, Mr. O'Brien.
8	MR. O'BRIEN: I don't have it.
9	AGENT FLETCHER: Mr. O'Brien does not
10	have the document that you are referring to, so
11	we're going to have to make sure you get that,
12	Mr. O'Brien.
13	MR. O'BRIEN: Thank you.
14	AGENT FLETCHER: Yeah, because it was
15	not submitted all at one time.
16	MR. O'BRIEN: Okay.
17	AGENT FLETCHER: Mr. O'Brien, I'm
18	making a note of that right now. When I get back
19	to my desk, I'll email it to you.
20	MR. O'BRIEN: Email it to me, that's
21	fine.
22	AGENT FLETCHER: We don't need to set

1	any dates, mediation, Status, Protest Hearing,
2	there's nothing we need to do because the Board
3	now has to make a decision about whether or not
4	the Protestants have standing to follow protest.
5	Any questions at all, Mr. Levy?
6	MR. LEVY: Well, we'll respond to the
7	motion to dismiss shortly.
8	AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Well, thank
9	you for coming.
10	MR. LEVY: All right.
11	AGENT FLETCHER: Roll Call Hearing is
12	concluded.
