4	calendar is show cause Case Number 19-CMP-00036,
5	Truxton Inn, License Number 101217. Would the
6	parties please approach and identify themselves
7	for the record, please?
8	MR. LUI: Good morning, John Lui on
9	behalf of the District of Columbia.
10	CHAIR ANDERSON: Good morning, Mr. Lui.
11	MR. KLINE: Good morning, Andrew Kline
12	on behalf of the Applicant.
13	CHAIR ANDERSON: Good morning, Mr.
14	Kline.
15	MR. WEISS: Good morning, Matthew
16	Weiss, owner Truxton Inn.
17	CHAIR ANDERSON: Good morning, Mr.
18	Weiss.
19	MR. WEISS: Good morning.
20	CHAIR ANDERSON: Are there any
21	preliminary matters in this case?
22	MR. LUI: Yes, there is an offer in
23	compromise to present to the Board.
24	CHAIR ANDERSON: And what is that,
25	please?

1	MR. LUI: This is for Charge 1, the
2	failure to obtain an off-premise storage permit,
3	this is a primary tier violation. The offer in
4	compromise has two terms. The first is a written
5	warning. And the second is that this off-premise
6	storage unit, I believe it was 249 Florida
7	Avenue, shall be accessible for inspection within
8	the next 72 hours.
9	CHAIR ANDERSON: You said the off what?
10	MR. LUI: The off-premise storage unit
11	shall
12	CHAIR ANDERSON: By whom?
13	MR. LUI: Shall be accessible for
14	inspection by
15	MR. KLINE: ABRA investigators
16	MR. LUI: ABRA investigators.
17	MR. KLINE: Mr. Chairman. And to
18	clarify, the off-premise storage unit that we're
19	talking about is an apartment upstairs, where the
20	manager lived, he no longer lives there. And
21	that's where there was some overflow beverages
22	and they were immediately removed when that was
23	pointed out by the investigator.
24	CHAIR ANDERSON: All right. Mr. Kline,
25	it's my understanding that there is an offer in

compromise in this matter. The offer in compromise is that there is a, for the charge, a written warning will be issued and that the off-premises storage area will be accessible for investigation by ABRA investigators within the next 72 hours. Is this your understanding, sir, of the offer in compromise?

MR. KLINE: Yes, Mr. Chairman.

CHAIR ANDERSON: Is your client aware that by accepting an offer in compromise, that they are giving up their right to a hearing?

MR. KLINE: Yes, Mr. Chairman.

CHAIR ANDERSON: And is your client also aware that by accepting an offer in compromise, that they are giving up, that he's giving up his right to appeal this matter?

MR. KLINE: Yes.

CHAIR ANDERSON: With this said, I then make a motion that the offer in compromise for Charge 1, that a written warning be issued and that the off-premises property shall be accessible for inspection by the ABRA investigators within the next 72 hours be accepted. Is there a second?
