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**FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW,  
AND ORDER**

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The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) finds that Partners at 723 8th Street SE, LLC, t/a The Ugly Mug Dining Saloon, (hereinafter “Respondent” or “Ugly Mug”) violated 25-113(b)(2)(A) by failing to timely file the quarterly statement for the period ending on December 31, 2019, which was due on January 30, 2020 (Charge I). The Board, on this 6th day of October 2021, hereby issues a **WARNING** for the offense where the business has undergone serious financial hardship due to the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic and has no delinquent quarterly reports at this time. The Board advises the Respondent to file its quarterly

reports in a timely fashion in the future. The ABRA shall deliver copies of this Order to the Government and the Respondent.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, Reeves Center, 2000 14th Street, NW, 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202-879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. *See* D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
