ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF RENEWAL APPLICATION

The Application filed by Union Kitchen, LLC, t/a Union Kitchen (Applicant), for Renewal of its Retailer’s Class B License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on December 21, 2020, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On December 21, 2020, the Board dismissed the Application because the Applicant failed to appear at the Roll Call Hearing. *See* Board Order 2020-1034.

On December 28, 2020, Cullen Gilchrist, on behalf of the Applicant, filed a request for reinstatement. Mr. Gilchrist seeks the reinstatement of the Application so that the Application and the Settlement Agreement can be approved by the Board.

Upon consideration of this request to reinstate the Application, the Board finds that the Applicant's request constitutes good cause pursuant to 23 DCMR 1602.3.

ORDER

For these reasons, the Board does hereby, this 6th day of January 2021, **REINSTATE** the Application filed by Union Kitchen, LLC, t/a Union Kitchen, for renewal of its Retailer's Class B License.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
