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**ORDER ON DISMISSAL OF  
THE GROUP OF FIVE OR MORE INDIVIDUALS' PROTEST**

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The Application filed by Union Hospitality Group, LLC, t/a Union Oyster Bar & Lounge (Applicant), for a Substantial Change to add a Sports Wagering Endorsement to its Retailer's Class CR License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on April 18, 2022, and a Protest Status Hearing on May 18, 2022, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On May 18, 2022, the Board dismissed the Protest of the Group of Five or More Individuals because the Group of Five or More Individuals failed to appear at the Protest Status Hearing. The Group of Five or More Individuals may file a Request for Reinstatement with the Board within ten (10) days from the date of this Order.

Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
