3 MS. FLETCHER: Would the parties in  
4 the matter of Uproar please come forward, the  
5 parties in the matter of Uproar?

6 This is Case No. 20-PRO-0005, Ching,  
7 LLC, 639 Florida Avenue, Northwest, License No.  
8 092012, Retailer Class CT, Substantial Change,  
9 expansion to rooftop summer garden from 94 to 200  
10 patrons. The protest issues are adverse impact  
11 on peace, order, and quiet.

12 My name is LaVerne Fletcher,  
13 conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's  
14 agent. Introductions beginning with the  
15 applicant, please. Good morning. If you could  
16 just state your name and spell it for the record.

17 MR. MARTIN: Good morning. Thomas  
18 Martin representing -- T-H-O-M-A-S M-A-R-T-I-N,  
19 representing Uproar.

20 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Martin.  
21 Would you put your contact information on the  
22 sheet? Thank you very much. Present on behalf  
23 of ANC 1B?

24 MS. NORMAN: Anita Norman, A-N-I-T-A  
25 N-O-R-M-A-N.

1 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Norman.  
2 Ms. Norman, do you know if you're going to be the  
3 representative for ANC 1B in this case?

4 MS. NORMAN: Yes, I am.

5 MS. FLETCHER: This is your case?

6 MS. NORMAN: This is my case.

7 MS. FLETCHER: Perfect. Thank you.

8 ANC 1B has standing as a protestant. We need to  
9 set a date for mediation, a status hearing, and a  
10 protest hearing. I'll give you the day for the  
11 status and protest hearing first. The status  
12 hearing is set for March 25 at 9:30 a.m. That's  
13 March 25 at 9:30 a.m. for the status hearing.

14 MS. NORMAN: At 9:00?

15 MS. FLETCHER: At 9:30.

16 MS. NORMAN: 9:30?

17 MS. FLETCHER: Mm-hmm. The protest  
18 hearing is set for April 29, 2020 at 1:30. I  
19 will give you the next available day for  
20 mediation. The next available day for mediation  
21 is Thursday, March the 5th at 9:00 o'clock or  
22 11:00 o'clock a.m. Does that work?

23 MS. NORMAN: Say it again.

24 MS. FLETCHER: Thursday, March 5 --  
25 Thursday, March the 5th at either 9:00 o'clock or

1 11:00 o'clock. That's the next available day.

2 MR. MARTIN: Either would work for our  
3 side.

4 MS. NORMAN: Give me one second.

5 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

6 MS. NORMAN: Do you have another  
7 dated?

8 MS. FLETCHER: Yes. The next day is  
9 Tuesday, March 10 at 11:00 or 11:30. It's  
10 Tuesday, March 10 at 11:00 or 11:30.

11 MR. MARTIN: Either of those times  
12 would work for us.

13 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you.

14 MS. NORMAN: I have two other  
15 appointments --

16 MS. FLETCHER: On that day?

17 MS. NORMAN: -- the following day. We  
18 can go back to the 5th of the March.

19 MS. FLETCHER: We could also do it on  
20 March 12 if you prefer, or we can go back to the  
21 --

22 MS. NORMAN: No, March --

23 MS. FLETCHER: -- 5th.

24 MS. NORMAN: March 5th, yes.

25 MS. FLETCHER: So it was March 5th at

1 9:00 or 11:00.

2 MS. NORMAN: Either one.

3 MS. FLETCHER: Do you have a  
4 preference? Okay. Then let's just make it -- do  
5 you have a preference, Mr. Martin?

6 MR. MARTIN: We do not.

7 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Then let's just  
8 make it at 11:00 on March the 5th. Mediation set  
9 for Thursday, March 5 at 11:00.

10 MR. MARTIN: Understood. Thank you.

11 MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome. Any  
12 questions at all?

13 MR. MARTIN: No.

14 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Well, thank you  
15 for coming. See you then. Roll call hearing  
16 concluded.
