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**ORDER DENYING THE PETITIONER'S REQUEST FOR  
REINSTATEMENT OF CANCELLED LICENSE**

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On May 12, 2021, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued Board Order No. 2021-266 cancelling VD 3, LLC (Petitioner), License No. ABRA-108288.

The Board cancelled the license because the Petitioner failed to renew its license by March 31, 2021, the deadline for all Retailer's Class A licenses to renew, despite being notified of the renewal date. *See* Board Order No. 2021-266.

On July 19, 2022, Chrissie Chang, on behalf of the Petitioner, sought reinstatement of the cancelled Retailer's Class A License No. ABRA-108288.

D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1) states that one may petition the Board for reconsideration of the Board's decision within ten (10) days after receiving the Board's final order. The Petitioner submitted his Request for Reinstatement to the Board on July 19, 2022; more than one (1) year after receiving the Board's Order.

Thus, the Board does not find that the Petitioner's argument constitutes good cause, and the request was untimely filed; therefore, the Petitioner's request is **DENIED**.

### **ORDER**

For these reasons, the Board does hereby, this 27th day of July 2022, **DENY** the reinstatement of VD 3, LLC's Retailer's Class A License No. ABRA-108288.

Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
