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**ORDER ON PRAECIPE OF DISMISSAL**


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On February 20, 2018, the District of Columbia (Government) filed a Praecipe of Dismissal seeking dismissal of the charges listed in the Notices to Show Cause Hearing filed against Mimi & D, LLC, t/a Vita Restaurant and Lounge/Penthouse Nine (Respondent), in Case Nos. 17-CMP-00640 and 17-CMP-00682. *See* ABRA Show Cause File Nos. 17-CMP-00640 and 17-CMP-00682.

The Government seeks to dismiss the charge because on February 14, 2018, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board cancelled the Respondent's License No. ABRA-086037. *See* Board Order No. 2018-057.



Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
