4	the matter of the Watergate Hotel, please come
5	forward the parties in the matter of the
6	Watergate Hotel?
7	This is case number 19-PRO-00032,
8	Watergate Hotel, Lessee, LLC, 2650 Virginia
9	Avenue Northwest, Unit Number H-1, License Number
10	ABRA-091162. This is a retailer class CH license
11	renewal.
12	The protest issues are adverse impact
13	on peace, order, and quiet. My name is La Verne
14	Fletcher, conducting the Roll Call Hearing as the
15	Board's Agent, introductions beginning with the
16	Applicant, please.
17	MR. O'BRIEN: Stephen O'Brien for the
18	Applicant.
19	AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr.
20	O'Brien. And present on behalf of ANC 2A?
21	MR. SACCO: Peter Sacco, representing
22	ANC 2A.

1	AGENT FLETCHER: Mr. Sacco, would you
2	spell your last name?
3	MR. SACCO: Yes, Sacco, S-A-C-C-O.
4	AGENT FLETCHER: Is anyone present on
5	behalf of the Group of Five? Anyone present on
6	behalf of the Group of Five?
7	MR. SACCO: There is a Group of Five?
8	MS. ROHDE: Yes, we're here. I can
9	barely hear.
LO	AGENT FLETCHER: Maybe the microphone
L1	is out in the back. Maybe the microphone is out
L2	in the back, that's okay. If you're present just

L 4	MS. ROHDE: We're all supposed to come
L5	sit up here?
L6	AGENT FLETCHER: Yes. Initially, just

13	AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
14	MS. PAZ: My name is Rina Paz, R-I-N-A
15	P-A-Z.
16	AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
17	MR. COLLETTE: My name is Royal
18	Collette, C-O-L-E-T-T-E.
19	AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you.
19 20	AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you. MR. GESSNER: Richard Gessner, last

1	MS. EVANS: I'm Christine Evans with
2	a C-H first name, and then E-V-A-N-S.
3	AGENT FLETCHER: What's the last name,
4	Christine?
5	MS. EVANS: Evans.
6	AGENT FLETCHER: Now Ms. Evans, I
7	didn't see your name on the protest letter, did
8	you sign the protest letter?
9	MS. EVANS: No.
10	AGENT FLETCHER: Okay, that means that
11	you're not a Protestant, but you're free to
12	support the protest as we move through the
13	process. For example, if we have any hearings
14	these are public hearings. You're welcome to
15	come. If this matter goes forward for a protest
16	hearing, you're welcome to come
17	MS. EVANS: Okay.
18	AGENT FLETCHER: and just be
19	present in support of the group.
20	MS. EVANS: Okay.
21	AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
22	So of the individuals present today,

1	are either one of you going to be the designated
2	representative for the group?
3	(No audible response.)
4	AGENT FLETCHER: Ms. Rohde, that's
5	going to be you?
6	MS. ROHDE: I will be. I have a bit
7	of a head cold, so you're going to have talk up
8	if I'm going to hear you.
9	AGENT FLETCHER: Well, you know, it's
10	probably did you say can you better hear
11	now?
12	MS. ROHDE: I can hear better now,
13	yes.
14	AGENT FLETCHER: Oh yeah, it's in the
15	back. I'm sorry, the microphones aren't working
16	back there.
17	MS. ROHDE: Is the microphone on? Can
18	everybody hear
19	PARTICIPANT: I can hear.
20	MS. ROHDE: everybody else? It's
21	just my head, I guess.
22	AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Well, I can

still speak louder.

MS. ROHDE: Thank you.

AGENT FLETCHER: ANC 2A has standing as a Protestant. The Group of Five is granted conditional standing as a Protestant. What that means is, four of you are present today. You're granted conditional standing until at the upcoming Status Hearing one more person appears.

The Board has to see five faces in order to grant full standing, but you're going to be granted conditional standing today. So we'll just move forward --

MS. ROHDE: Okay.

AGENT FLETCHER: -- the way we would if you were granted full standing.

At the upcoming Status Hearing, you're going to receive a Status Hearing date. Once you get that date, one person who's not here today needs to appear, Donna Barbisch is the only person who must appear. You can appear also Ms.

Rohde --

MS. ROHDE: Yes.

1 AGENT FLETCHER: -- as the designated 2 representative for the group. You may come to the Status Hearing along with Ms. Barbisch. 3 MS. ROHDE: Okay, do we know what date 4 5 that is yet? No, we don't know the 6 AGENT FLETCHER: 7 date yet. Normally, I have Status and Protest 8 Hearing days on the date of the Roll Call 9 Hearing, but the person that provides those dates 10 has not yet returned from leave. So today, I 11 don't have a Status Hearing date. 12 MS. ROHDE: Donna is a retired 13 two-star General, and she travels a great deal. 14 So as soon as we could -- that's why she's not 15 here today. As soon as we could get that date, 16 that would be helpful. 17 AGENT FLETCHER: You will get that 18 date, you're going to receive an official hearing 19 -- you're going to receive an official hearing 20 notice. That hearing notice is going to have the 21 Status Hearing date in it.

Once you get that notice, you can --

10	MS. ROHDE: Very good.	
11	AGENT FLETCHER: And so the Group of	
12	Five is granted conditional standing. Any other	
13	questions about that?	
14	(No audible response.)	
15	AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you.	
16	Did you sign on the put your information on	
17	the contact sheet?	
18	(No audible response.)	
19	AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you. We need	
20	to set a date for mediation. I'll give you the	
21	next available day. The next available day for	
22	mediation is June 10 at 1:00 or 2:00 in the	

1	afternoon, or June 20.
2	MR. O'BRIEN: June 10 at 1:00 would be
3	fine with me.
4	AGENT FLETCHER: Does that work for
5	you, Mr. Sacco?
6	MR. SACCO: One of our commissioners
7	will be handling it, Commissioner Smith, and I'm
8	sure he can make that work.
9	MS. ROHDE: We will try. Absolutely.
10	June 10 at 1:00 p.m., correct?
11	AGENT FLETCHER: Yeah, June 10 at 1:00
12	p.m., that's on a Monday.
13	And Ms. Rohde if, you know, anything
14	changes on your end, if you have the request to
15	change any dates just always contact Mr. O'Brien
16	first to
17	MS. ROHDE: Do you have a card?
18	MR. O'BRIEN: Yes, I do.
19	MS. ROHDE: Thank you.
20	AGENT FLETCHER: And one other thing,
21	Ms. Rohde, if you have the need to request a
