ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF RENEWAL APPLICATION

The Application filed by Kookoovaya, Inc., t/a We, The Pizza (Applicant), for renewal of its Retailer's CR License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on July 5, 2022.

On July 13, 2022, the Board dismissed the Application because the Applicant failed to appear at the Roll Call Hearing. *See* Board Order 2022-310.

On July 15, 2022, Jeff Jackson, on behalf of the Applicant, filed a request for reinstatement. Mr. Jackson explained that the Applicant did not appear at the Roll Call Hearing due to an unexpected death in the family.

Upon consideration of this request to reinstate the Application, the Board finds that the reason for the Applicant's failure to appear constitutes good cause pursuant to 23 DCMR 1602.3.

ORDER

For these reasons, the Board does hereby, this 27th day of July 2022, **REINSTATE** the Application filed by Kookoovaya, Inc., t/a We, The Pizza, for renewal of its Retailer's Class CR License.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code§ 25-433(d)(l), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thi1ty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Cou1t of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
