The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met in the Alcoholic Beverage Control Hearing Room, Reeves Building, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009, Chairperson Donovan W. Anderson, presiding.

1 P-R-O-C-E-E-D-I-N-G-S 2 (9:58 a.m.) CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case 3 4 on our calendar is Case No. 17-CC-00088, Fresh 5 Fields Whole Foods Market, License Number 60167. Would the parties please approach and 6 identify themself for the record, please? 7 8 MS. SCHMIDT: Good morning. Amy 9 Schmidt, Assistant Attorney General on behalf of District of Columbia. 10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Schmidt. 11 12 MS. YOHANNES: Sidon Yohannes on behalf of the licensee. 13 14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning again, Ms. Yohannes. 15 16 Are there any preliminary matters in 17 this case? 18 MS. SCHMIDT: Yes, there is. There 19 was an Offer-in-Compromise to be presented and that is for Charge I, a \$3000 fine to be paid 20 21 within 30 days or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine is paid. 22

The license shall be suspended for five days with all five days stayed for one year and all employees who serve alcoholic beverages in the licensed establishment shall complete an alcohol training program within three months from the OIC's date and Charge II will be dismissed.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, Ms. Yohannes. It's my understanding there is an Offer-in-Compromise. And the Offer-in-Compromise is that for Charge I there is a fine of \$3000 paid within 30 days.

If the fine is not paid within 30 days, the license will be suspended until the fine has been paid, that there is a five-day suspension. All five days will be stayed for one year, that all employees who sell or serve alcohol will undergo training within the next 90 days and that Charge II will be dismissed. Is this your understanding of the Offer-in-Compromise?

MS. YOHANNES: Yes, it is.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And is your

client aware that by accepting an Offer-inCompromise that they're giving up their rights to
a hearing?

MS. YOHANNES: Yes.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And does your client also, is aware that also by accepting this Offer-in-Compromise that they're giving up their right to appeal this matter?

MS. YOHANNES: Yes.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Any Board members have any questions of Counsel regarding this Offer-in-Compromise?
