

ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF APPLICATION

The Application filed by Wonder Mart, LLC, t/a Wonder Mart (Applicant), for a New Retailer's Class B License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on November 2, 2020, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001). On November 2, 2020, the Board dismissed the Application because the Applicant failed to appear at the Roll Call Hearing. The Applicant filed a Request for Reinstatement with the Board that was unopposed. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thilty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Coult of Appeals, 430 E StTeet, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion.
