4 present in the matter of Woodward Liquors?
5 Woodward Liquors, this is Case No. 18-PRO-00040,
6 Kay Dee, Inc., 6111 Blair Road, License No. ABRA-
7 086912. This is a Retailer Class A License
8 renewal.

9 The protest issues are adverse impact
10 on peace, order and quiet.

11 My name is LaVerne Fletcher. I'm
12 conducting the Roll Call Hearing as the Board's
13 Agent.

14 Are you here on behalf of the
15 applicant?

16 MR. DUTT: Yes, ma'am.

17 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay.

18 MR. DUTT: I am the owner of the
19 Woodward Liquor.

20 AGENT FLETCHER: I'm sorry, what was
21 that?

22 MR. DUTT: I'm the owner of the

1 Woodward Liquor.

2 AGENT FLETCHER: Oh, okay. Thank you.

3 And what's your name?

4 MR. DUTT: Varinder. The first name
5 is V-A-R-I-N --

6 AGENT FLETCHER: I'm sorry. I'm
7 sorry.

8 MR. DUTT: I'm sorry.

9 AGENT FLETCHER: Did you say V?

10 MR. DUTT: V, like Victor.

11 AGENT FLETCHER: Uh-huh.

12 MR. DUTT: A-R-I-N-D-E-R. Last name
13 is Dutt, D-U-T-T.

14 AGENT FLETCHER: What's the first
15 letter?

16 MR. DUTT: D, like David.

17 AGENT FLETCHER: D like David?

18 MR. DUTT: Uh-huh.

19 AGENT FLETCHER: What's next?

20 MR. DUTT: U, like Utah.

21 AGENT FLETCHER: Um-hum.

22 MR. DUTT: T, Tom, T, Tom.

1 AGENT FLETCHER: D-U?

2 MR. DUTT: T-T. T, like Tom.

3 AGENT FLETCHER: D-U-T?

4 MR. DUTT: T-T.

5 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Two Ts?

6 MR. DUTT: Yes, ma'am.

7 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you. And you
8 are present for Woodward Liquors?

9 MR. DUTT: Yes, ma'am.

10 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. And you can
11 have a seat. Thank you.

12 MR. DUTT: Thank you.

13 AGENT FLETCHER: Is anyone present on
14 behalf of ANC-4B? ANC-4B is dismissed, because
15 they did not appear today.

16 MR. DUTT: Oh, okay.

17 AGENT FLETCHER: And what that means--
18 have you had any communication with the ANC-4B?
19 There is not a settlement agreement or --

20 MR. DUTT: No, ma'am.

21 AGENT FLETCHER: -- any such thing?

22 MR. DUTT: No. Actually, I have a

1 number of people who signed it for me, that they
2 didn't find any threat from my store.

3 AGENT FLETCHER: Yeah, that's okay.
4 The ANC is dismissed because they are not here
5 today.

6 MR. DUTT: Oh, okay.

7 AGENT FLETCHER: They are going to
8 receive a Board Order dismissing the protest.

9 MR. DUTT: Oh, okay.

10 AGENT FLETCHER: All right. You will
11 -- they will have 10 days to ask the Board to
12 grant them standing as a protestant.

13 MR. DUTT: Oh, okay.

14 AGENT FLETCHER: If the Board -- I'm
15 going to need you to put your contact information
16 on that sheet anyway.

17 MR. DUTT: Oh, okay.

18 AGENT FLETCHER: So that you can
19 receive a copy of the Board Order dismissing the
20 protest.

21 MR. DUTT: Okay.

22 AGENT FLETCHER: And you will have an

1 opportunity to respond to any request they make
2 to be reinstated or to be granted standing, I
3 should say.

4 MR. DUTT: Okay.

5 AGENT FLETCHER: So if you would do
6 that? Thank you very much.

7 MR. DUTT: Thank you, ma'am.

8 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you for coming.

9 MR. DUTT: Thank you.

10 AGENT FLETCHER: The Roll Call Hearing
11 is concluded.

12 MR. DUTT: Thank you.

13 AGENT FLETCHER: You're very welcome.
