**ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE**



The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) has reviewed its records and determined that Zenebe Shewayene's License No. ABRA-100620 is currently in safekeeping.

On July 17 and September 20, 2019, the ABRA's Licensing Division provided a written notice to the Licensee notifying the Licensee that the safekeeping period for its license expired on September 30, 2019. The Licensee was further notified that if it wished to keep its license in Safekeeping, a written safekeeping extension request must be submitted to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) at least ten (10) days before September 30, 2019, or the license will be cancelled, pursuant to the District of Columbia Official Code § 25-791(c). No such request was received from the Licensee.

It is hereby **ORDERED** on this 23rd day of October, 2019, that Zenebe Shewayene's License No. ABRA-100620 is **CANCELLED**. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Respondent.



Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
