**ORDER GRANTING PETITIONER'S MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION
AND REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE**

On May 16, 2018, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) cancelled the Retailer Class B License No. ABRA-100620 held by Zenebe Shewayene, because Zenebe Shewayene failed to pay the safekeeping fee for his license. *See* Board Order No. 2018-333.

On November 5, 2018, Workneh Churnet, Esq., on behalf of Zenebe Shewayene (Petitioner), sought reinstatement of the Retailer's Class B License No. ABRA-100620. In support of his Motion for Reconsideration, Mr. Churnet stated that the Petitioner did not receive proper notice from the Board requesting that the Petitioner pay the safekeeping fee for his license or the Board would cancel its ABC license.

The Board finds good cause to grant the Motion to reinstate with the condition that the Petitioner pays the required fees.

Accordingly, it is this 28th day of November, 2018, **ORDERED** that the **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE** issued against Zenebe Shewayene, by the Board on May 16, 2018, be and hereby is **VACATED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Retailer Class B License ABRA-100620 be **REINSTATED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petitioner pays the required fees for his ABC License No. ABRA-100620 within two (2) weeks from the date of this Order.

A copy of this Order shall be sent to Counsel for the Petitioner.







Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
