The Alcoholic Beverage Cannabis Board (Board) will hold a hearing at 10:30 a.m. on Thursday, July 13, 2023, to receive public comment concerning the renewal of the Adams Morgan Moratorium Zone. The Board recently extended the moratorium on an emergency basis. It now seeks comment on a resolution adopted by Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 1C that, if approved by the Board, would increase the number of allowable tavern licenses to 25 to be phased in with no more than four new tavern licenses per year. The ANC Resolution is available on ABCA's website www.abca.dc.gov.

The Board's public hearing will be conducted via video conferencing through the Cisco Webex meetings (Webex) platform. Internet access is required. The hearing will also be streamed via YouTube.

Members of the public who are unable to testify or who do not desire to testify in person may provide written comments which will be included as part of the Board's official record. Copies of written statements should be submitted to ABCA General Counsel Martha Jenkins no later than **5:00 p.m. on Friday, July 14, 2023**.
